

Housetraining and Crate Schedule						
oal behaviour- to make housetraining as errorless as possible while also building crate time for future bsences. This is not a "set" schedule but an example. Feed times etc will vary from household to ousehold and so will walk times.						
Crate overnight						
Take Pup to pee IMMEDIATELY (carry if needed)						
Breakfast						
Fifteen Minutes of "free" time (Use a timer to make sure you do not miss it)						
Outside for pee						
Crate for 20 minutes						
Thirty minutes of free time supervised						
Outside for pee						
Crate for at least half an hour, longer if possible						
Outside for pee						
Thirty minutes of free time supervised (training, play, outdoors or indoors)						
Continue same process on and off.						
Gradually over the next week or two increase times free but continue to keep crate times at least 30 minute						
but no more than 2 hours						
Walks, outdoor play etc are unlimited but the key to this plan as a housetraining plan is to have him learn to						
hold it so the amount of time crated is to ensure puppy learns to hold it for periods.						
Make sure puppy is praised and REWARDED for every pee outside.
